Hi Joe,

Marie Antoinette (CLOSE) STINE was buried in Opelousas. Her husband may have moved back to Louisiana after her death. The social security death index shows a Frank Stine of the correct age to have had a last residence of 70570, which is Opelousas.

I do have some connections in your area though. My 3rd great-grandfather, George Washington ADDISON, removed from Georgetown, South Carolina to Opelousas, Louisiana in the early 1820's. He was the publisher of the Opelousas Gazette. He died in Opelousas in 1852. Of his siblings, only a sister named Elizabeth lived to have children. Elizabeth married Francis L. SIAU, son of Louis SIAU. Elizabeth (ADDISON) SIAU remained in Georgetown, South Carolina, however, her son, John Addison SIAU, removed to northeast Texas and is the progenitor of the SIAU family in Texas.

John Addison SIAU died August 25, 1852 in Jasper County, Texas. I do not know where he is buried. He was married to Caroline MOYER or DIXON. Caroline remarried Mr. PAINTER, and later to Mr. GARVIN. I do not know where she is buried. Children of John Addison SIAU and wife, Caroline, were Jane SIAU, born abt 1850 (nothing more is known about Jane) and William Frances/Franis SIAU. William Frances/Franis SIAU married Lenora Vergie MATTHEW. William Francis SIAU and Lenora (and several other of their SIAU descendants) are buried in Bean Cemetery, in or near Kirbyville, Jasper County, Texas.

Their Children:

- 1) Callie SIAU married Joshua KARR . Both are buried in Bean Cemetery
- 2) James Crawford SIAU married Mary Narcisis "Mollie/Molly" BEASLEY. Both are buried in Bean Cemetery
- 3) John Spencer SIAU married "Dot". He is buried in Bean Cemetery. I do not know where Dot is buried. Their children were born in Hardin County, Texas.
- 4) Anna Elizabeth "Annie" SIAU married Mr. GUTHRIE. She is buried in Bean Cemetery. I not nothing more of Mr. Guthrie.
- 5) Thomas Sloan SIAU married Ina Mae TRUITT. I do not know where they are buried. Their children were born in Newton County, Texas.
- 6) Jefferson Davis "Jeff" SIAU married Leona KELLEY. Both are buried in Davis Cemetery in Jasper County, Texas.
- 7) William Francis SIAU, Jr. born Mar. 1890. I have nothing more on him.
- 8) Robert E. Lee SIAU married Mae Hildred "Hilda" NOBLES. He is buried in King Cemetery in Hartburg, Newton County, Texas. She is buried in Hartburg Cemetery.
- 9) Oscar Oliver SIAU married Beulah LEE. Both are buried in Bean Cemetery
- 10) Chester Henry SIAU (sometimes Henry Chester SIAU) married Gladys PEARL. He is buried in Bean Cemetery. Gladys died 24 Mar. 1890 in Atascosa County. I don't know where she is buried.
- 11) George Either SIAU married 1st) Stella Blanche NEWEL; married 2nd) Fannie Rachel CARR/KARR. George is buried in Harris Cemetery, Orange County, Texas. I don't know where his wives were buried.
- 12) Stella SIAU (nothing more known about Stella)
- 13) Ada Pearl SIAU married Joe WILKINSON. Both died in Newton County, Texas. I do not

know where they were buried.

14) girl SIAU. un-named infant. Do not know where she is buried.

Because most of the information comes from Death Certificates, I have no photos. I did post memorials to most on Findagrave.

Other surnames closely associated with the ADDISON and SIAU families were HARRELL and TARBOX. I don't know if any of those families removed to TEXAS with John ADDISON SIAU.

I am in New Braunfels, Comal County, Texas. I sometimes visit Washington County, Texas. If you have a grave in those areas, let me know and I will try to get the photos. I am in a wheelchair though, so I cannot always get into areas I would like to.

I will try to revisit your webpage at intervals to see what info I can add to what you already have. Here is one little bit I picked up:

You show "Callie Stella BILM". Her surname should read "BIHM".

According to SOUTHWEST LOUISIANA RECORDS by Donald J. Hebert

Callie Stella Leblanc BIHM was born 21 Sept 1866 to Jesse BIHM and Emilie DEAN (Leonville Ch.: v. 2, p. 55). That LeBlanc is shown in the entry, tells me this entry was added later.

Joe,

I wanted to fill you in on another person: Marie Louise BARRE', daughter of Charles Alexandre BARRE' and Magdelaine DeCUIR <http://www.peerygenealogy.com/home/p14.htm#i2247>.

You show some of her marriages. I have found more:

Marie Louise BARRE married:

- 1) Joseph Pierre NEZAT, son of Pierre NEZAT and Marie Magdelaine PREVOST, on 18 June 1792 in Opelousas, Louisiana.
- 2) She married Ashford Violet, son of Thomas Violet and Cressy Ashford, on 14 December 1811 in St. Martinville, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana. Ashford VIOLETT was murdered on 27 August 1812 in a disagreement over a slave. Ashford's brother was implicated in his murder.
- 3) She married Edward "Edouard" ROBERTSON/ROBINSON, son of Thomas ROBERTSON/ROBINSON and Nancy Chery, on 4 November 1813 in St. Martinville, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.
- 4) She married Drury Wood "D. W." BREAZEALE, son of Willis BREAZEALE and Sarah WOOD, on 19 July 1819 in Adams County, Mississippi.
- 5) She married Thomas SPRAGINS, also known as "Daddy SPRAGGINS", a "hard shell" baptist preacher (son of Thomas SPRAGINS and Maacah ABNEY), on September 30, 1841 in Claiborne County, Mississippi. I have a copy of that marriage bond. Thomas SPRAGINS traveled a lot between Mississippi and Texas. His daughter's bible shows that he died in Feb. 20 1843 in Velasco, Brazoria County, Texas. In a letter dated Nov 1843, from Marie Louise,

written to her family in Louisiana, she wrote: "If my husband had lived we intended to visit you this fall."

6) She married William S. BENTLEY on 1 Nov. 1845 in Claiborne County, Mississippi. The transcription of their marriage bond shows him as William A. Bentley, however the 1850 US Census shows him as William S. Bentley. I intend to try to get a copy of the actual marriage bond.
